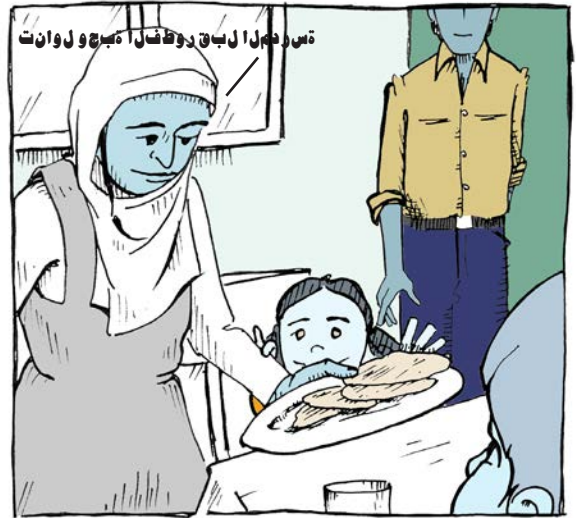
Investigating what makes you curious is called research. Whether you share what you discover or keep it for yourself, what you are doing is the beginning of art or science (and may be both together!).
